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# CLOUD OF WITNESSES

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We stand surrounded by those who have gone before us,  
an enormous Cloud of Witnesses.

—Hebrews 12:1

The scripture in Matthew 22:32 says, *“I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Our God is not the God of the dead. He is the God of the living,”* This means that those who have passed away and are now in God’s presence, like Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, are still alive as eternal spirits. They remember the lessons they learned while on Earth, but all their sorrows have been erased.

In this book, I share a treasure trove of soul-stirring messages I received from these Saints, who are the Patriarchs, Prophets, and Bible heroes. They have the same sweet spirit of humility as Jesus, and their life lessons provide valuable insights to help you navigate your spiritual journey on Earth and strengthen your faith.

It’s essential to understand the concept of the Cloud of Witnesses before exploring this book. Without comprehension, you may have mental barriers that prevent you from receiving the practical wisdom imparted by these Saints.

So, please read through this entire chapter for clarity on this topic. I ask that you prayerfully consider my explanation before making a final decision.



**We Are Family**

When we accept Jesus as our Savior, we experience a spiritual rebirth and receive the gift of eternal life. Although our physical bodies may eventually die, our spirits live on eternally. When we transition to Heaven, we become a member of the Cloud of Witnesses. As members, we will pray for and cheer on the Christians living on Earth.

As Christians still living on Earth, we share a common bond with these Kingdom of Saints in Heaven, where Father God's omnipresent love unites us now as one big family.

Hebrews 11:39-12:1 speaks of these Saints, "These all, having had testimony given to them through their faith, didn't receive the promise, God having provided some better thing concerning us so that apart from us they should not be made perfect. Therefore let's also, seeing we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, lay aside every weight and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let's run with perseverance the race that is set before us."

These verses enlighten us about the legacy of faith left by these individuals, recorded in the Scriptures, which we can learn from. They continue to serve as a source of hope and motivation for all Christians, even though they have passed on from this world and now live in Heaven. When Jesus sends these Saints to us for inspiration and encouragement, we are reminded of their victorious faith and the heroic example they set for us.



### **Fundamental Tenet**

Have you ever heard of the Communion of Saints? A spiritual bond that unites Christians on Earth with the Saints in Heaven. This belief has been a fundamental tenet of the Christian faith for centuries and is explicitly stated in the Apostle's Creed.

As a confirmed Missouri Synod Lutheran church member until 1973, I recited this Creed every Sunday for twenty-two years. One phrase that always stood out to me was the "Communion of Saints," the tenet that connects all believers in the Body of Christ into a single spiritual unit linked to Jesus Christ, the Head of the Body.



Imagine having encounters with Saints from Heaven who share encouraging messages that strengthen your faith and offer scriptural wisdom. This happened when Jesus taught me about these visitations and removed the barriers to understanding their truth.

My encounters with the Saints were validated by watching the Christian Prophets Sadhu Sundar Selvaraj and Lovy Elias on YouTube, who both have highly respected worldwide ministries and have encounters with the Saints. I later discovered that these men and I also shared a common thread. Not only did the Saints visit us, but we experienced ongoing face-to-face encounters with Jesus throughout our lives.



### **The Choice is Yours**

However, some Christians doubt that visitations from Saints are divinely sanctioned. They believe that communicating with the dead, which is considered an act of necromancy, is involved in such encounters. I used to share this belief, not realizing that the teachings of misinformed church leaders had influenced my perspective. These leaders told me that visitations from Heavenly Saints were only meant for biblical times and Christian mystics of the past.

Conversely, Jesus later revealed that being part of the Communion of Saints is a significant aspect of the Christian faith that helps us grow closer to God. As a result, my skepticism vanished, and I began to see my visitations from Saints as holy experiences sent by Jesus for my benefit. Moreover, the beneficial spiritual fruit from these encounters further strengthened my belief that these visits are not an act of necromancy. Instead, they are sacred experiences that Jesus chose to send.

As a Spirit-filled Christian, I have had some remarkable spiritual experiences that I believe, without any doubt, were sent to me by Jesus. But how can I be sure that they are authentic? First, it's important to note that I have never asked Jesus for these experiences – they have always been His ideas. Secondly, Jesus has always told me when to expect a visitation from one of His chosen Saints. Thirdly, when a Saint does appear, I ask them, “Did Jesus Christ from Nazareth come in the flesh?” and each one answers,

“Yes.’ If a demon were to appear instead, they would either say “no,’ remain silent or ignore the question altogether. Fourthly, every message the Saints have brought has encouraged my faith journey and has always glorified Jesus, Father God, or the Holy Spirit. Finally, I have found that a thread of scripture supports these visitations throughout the Bible that I will share with you.

Ultimately, whether or not you choose to believe in these experiences is up to you. I have decided to reframe my thinking to align with the understanding Jesus Himself gave me.



### **Scriptural Perspective**

In the Bible, there is an example of necromancy in 1 Samuel 28:3-15. King Saul went against God’s command and consulted a witch to call upon the spirit of Prophet Samuel, who had already passed away. The witch was a practitioner of necromancy who had only interacted with demonic spirits in the past. To her surprise, the authentic spirit of Prophet Samuel appeared before her, which terrified her as she had never experienced a genuine visitation from a holy member of the “Cloud of Witnesses.’ She had only dealt with demonic spirits who disguised themselves as the dead person she was trying to conjure.

This particular scripture, 1 Samuel 28:3-15, is often cited by Christian critics to support their belief that visitations from the Saints are the work of the devil. However, if that were true, then Jesus being visited by Saints Moses and Elijah on the Mount of Transfiguration would also be considered necromancy. But we know that this is not the case.

There is no way that Jesus, who was sinless, would engage in necromancy. If the Saints were demons in disguise, Jesus would have cast them away from Him rather than speaking with them.

Understanding that visits from the “Cloud of Witnesses” are biblically sound and possible for Christians is essential. They are not the work of the devil but a holy experience that can strengthen spiritual fortitude and produce intimacy with God.

In Luke 9:28-32, we find verses that reveal the true nature of Saint visitations: “*Jesus took Peter, John, and James up on a mountain to pray.*

*As He was praying, the appearance of His face was transformed, and His clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly, two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared and began talking with Jesus. They were glorious to see. And they were speaking about His exodus from this world, which was about to be fulfilled in Jerusalem. Peter and the others had fallen asleep. When they woke up, they saw Jesus' glory and the two men standing with Him."*

The Cloud of Witness visitation to Jesus before His crucifixion is a biblical testament to their authenticity and divine nature. What's impressive is that this event is not considered necromancy because of Jesus's interaction with them and the three disciples' response to their eyewitness accounts. This experience moved Peter so much that he wanted to build three tents, one for each Saint, to observe and identify them.

There is scriptural support for the belief that Saints from the Cloud of Witnesses can visit someone on Earth. Revelation 22:8-9 describes an encounter between John and an angel who showed him things. When John fell to worship the angel, the angel corrected him, saying he should not be worshipped as he was just a servant of God like John and a Prophet. Therefore, the angel that John encountered was a Prophet Saint from the Cloud of Witnesses.

The Holy Spirit also validated these events by ensuring they were included in the Bible as examples of this type of visitation. This is a biblical testament to the authenticity and divine nature of the Heavenly Saints' appearing to Jesus before His crucifixion.

By reading about these holy events, you'll find yourself empowered by their wisdom. They inspire you to move forward with a new clarity of Father God's divine purpose for your life as a Bride of Christ, a more profound love for Jesus as your Bridegroom, and a clearer understanding of your relationship with the Holy Spirit, who opens your spiritual vision to God's mysteries.
